## MediaCityUK welcomes considerate cyclists and pedestrians who follow the Code of Conduct

- 1. Always give way to pedestrians and wheelchair users they have priority within MediaCityUK.
- 2. Slow down when cycling the public realm areas (piazza, footpaths and other public spaces) and in a manner that is considerate to the comfort and safety of others. Pedestrians should use the footpaths provided.
- 3. When cycling, dismount at the MediaCityUK footbridge (in between BBC Quay and Bridge House and across to the ITV Studios).
- 4. When it is dark or dull conditions ensure you are visible to others cyclists should use lights at night.
- 5. Pedestrians and cyclists should be particularly careful at junctions, bends, entrances onto the paths, or any other 'blind spots' where other users could appear in front of you without warning.
- 6. Cycle at a speed appropriate to the conditions and ensure you can stop in time. Pedestrians should ensure they are aware of approaching cyclists.
- 7. Be courteous and patient when space is limited or if you cannot see clearly ahead.
- 8. Cyclists should signal clearly at all times and use a bell not all pedestrians can see you.
- 9. Keep your bike secure and lock it when not in use.
